Stated Objectives

Scope, Purpose and Context

- Regulating generation, transmission, distribution and consumption
- To ensure reliability, suitable prices and environmental protection
- Providing for competition and avoiding monopolization
- Consideration of the interests of
 - ▶ Electric power consumers
 - ▶ Producers, transmitters and distributors (the “Electric Utility”)



Agency Powers

- Compliance with laws and regulations including environmental protection
- System planning and capital expenditures
- Compliance with operation standards and technical performance
- Ensuring technical, financial and economic capabilities for the Electric Utility
- Ensuring the quality of the technical and administrative services provided by the Electric Utility to the consumers



Board Functions

- Setting organizational structure
- Rules of procedure
- Issuing decisions on licenses
- Consumer protection performance standards
- Resolving consumer complaints
- Resolving competition complaints
- Setting license and service fees
